The 28th Judicial District Nominating Commission will convene at 9:30 a.m., Monday, July 21, 2025, to interview and select nominees to be submitted to the Governor to fill the vacancy in the 28th Judicial District created by the retirement of the Honorable Rene Young, on August 1, 2025.

The Commission will welcome recommendations of nominees to fill the position, but recommendations must be accompanied by a nomination form that is completed and signed by the nominee. The nomination form is available from the Clerk of the Appellate Courts; online at www.kscourts.gov/judge/vacancies; the Court Administrator, located in Saline County; or from the District Court Clerk in each of the following counties: Saline and Ottawa.

Nominees for district judge must be:

- at least 30 years old;
- a lawyer admitted to practice in Kansas and engaged in the practice of law for at least five years, whether as a lawyer, judge, or full-time teacher at an accredited law school; and
- a resident of the 28th Judicial District at the time of taking office and while holding office.
