**Order Certifying Additional Divisions and Positions for New Judges of the District Court,  
Certifying Vacancies, and Designating Locations**

Under K.S.A. 20-355 and 2022 House Substitute for Substitute for Senate Bill No. 267, which appropriates nonspecific funding to create fourteen new district judge divisions (DJ) and nine new district magistrate judge positions (DMJ), the Supreme Court hereby certifies the creation of the new divisions and positions as follows:
