WHEREAS, under the provisions of Laws of 1976, Chapter 146, Sec. 44, the administrative judge of each judicial district shall have control and supervision of expenditures under the budget established for the district court, subject to Supreme Court rules relating thereto; it is by the Court ordered that the following rules be promulgated:

- 1. Each administrative judge shall designate a fiscal officer in each county to initiate expenditures from the court's budget subject to the supervision of the administrative judge.
- 2. The clerk of the district court may be designated as the fiscal officer to assist in managing the court's budget.
- 3. All expenditures for the operation of all court offices within each county shall be processed by the fiscal officer under supervision of the administrative judge.
- 4. The fiscal officer shall maintain accounts on all budgetary matters and shall regularly report to the administrative judge on the status of the court's budget.
- 5. These rules shall become effective January 10, 1977.
