Pursuant to Article 3, Section 1 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas and the inherent power of the Supreme Court, this Court hereby creates the Specialty Courts Commission.

The duties of the Commission shall be to:

- 1. Study the status of specialty courts in existence in Kansas;
- 2. Suggest procedures for judicial districts to consider in the establishment of specialty courts;
- 3. Consider whether statewide guidelines or standards for specialty courts should be established and if so, develop recommendations for such;
- 4. Consider whether changes to statutes or court rules are needed to accommodate effective specialty courts and, if so, develop recommendations for such:
- 5. Develop recommendations for a judicial education program on specialty courts for the 2014 state judicial conference; and
- 6. Report its findings to the Court.
