# RULES RELATING TO LANGUAGE ACCESS COMMITTEE

Rule 1701 and the heading above the rule are hereby amended, effective July 1, 2016.

### **RULE 1701**

#### LANGUAGE ACCESS COMMITTEE

(a) Purpose.

A <u>l</u>Language aAccess <u>c</u>Committee is established <u>to for the purpose of makeing</u> recommendations to the Supreme Court regarding the development and <u>ongoing</u> administration of a comprehensive language access program to further accessibility to the Kansas courts by persons with limited English proficiency.

- (b) Membership.
  - The cCommittee is will be composed of not more than 12twelve members.
- (c) Appointment.

The Supreme Court will appoints the committee members of the committee.

(d) Terms.

The terms of the inaugural members of the <u>c</u>Committee will be staggered. At the expiration of each inaugural member's term, the term of each succeeding member will be <u>3</u>three years. No member of the <u>c</u>Committee will be eligible for more than two consecutive terms. A member appointed to complete an unexpired term will be eligible to serve one more consecutive 3-year term. A member is eligible for one or more additional terms after a break in service.

- (e) OJA Representative and Liaison Justice.
  - (1) In addition to the members described in subsection (b):
    - (A) there will be a permanent, nonvoting seat on the <u>c</u>Committee for a representative of the Office of Judicial Administration; and
    - (B) the  $\underline{c}$ Chief  $\underline{j}$ Justice of the Supreme Court will designate a liaison  $\underline{j}$ ustice to the  $\underline{c}$ Committee.

(2) The persons serving on the <u>c</u>Committee under paragraph (e)(l) are not subject to a term limit under subsection (d).
