#### Rule 2.041

## **DOCKETING STATEMENT**

- (a) **Time to File.** No later than 21 60 days after a notice of appeal or cross-appeal is filed in a district court, the appellant or cross-appellant must file with the clerk of the appellate courts a docketing statement, along with other documents required under Rule 2.04. A motion to docket an appeal out of time must state good cause for the failure to timely docket the appeal.
- (b) **Service.** A copy of the docketing statement must be served on all <del>other</del> parties to the appeal or cross-appeal.
- (c) Answer to Docketing Statement. If the statement of facts or issues in a docketing statement is insufficient to provide the court a fair summary of the facts and or issues on appeal, an appellee or cross-appellee may file—not later than 15 days after service of the docketing statement—an answer to the docketing statement. an answer to the docketing statement. The answer must be filed no later than 15 days after the filing of either:
  - (1) a timely filed docketing statement or
  - (2) the order granting a motion to docket out of time.
- (d) **No Grounds for Relief.** No party may file a motion based on the contents of a docketing statement or an answer to a docketing statement.

(e) **Form.** A docketing statement and an answer to a docketing statement must be on the applicable judicial council form.
