6	OJA Update ▪ Dawn Huddleston ▪ Melanie McMurphy	a. Specialty Court (Rule 191) Committee – D. Huddleston updated that 5 sub-committees are meeting including Webpage, Start-ups, Conference and Associations, Data Collection, and Standards. These committees are meeting regularly. b. 2024 State Specialty Court Meeting – This meeting is scheduled for Sept. 17th-19 th is when the next meeting will be held in Salina. Brian Vesser from Salina is working with D. Huddleston to create a list of topics and speakers and having sessions last for no more than 1 ½ hours. c. Grant Funding – M. McMurphy reported that we have 2 applications submitted, one is through OBW and SAMSA. These would fund the 3 pilot Family Treatment Courts. There is an OJJDP, BJA, and COSSUP possibility and all these of these grants would be options to fund the FTC pilot counties. She reported that there is a plan to apply for BJA grants to help fund Adult Treatment Courts. This funding

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		would be used to replace adult drug court grants currently being used that are not intended to be used to sustain courts. She reported that the OJJA FTC opportunity is only awarding 8 grants. She said that 3 are start up awards, 3 enhancement awards, and 2 statewide awards. The 3 pilot counties are going to submit for the start-up awards individually.

Dultmeier reported that they were going to compile funding sources that districts are currently utilizing. D. Huddleston reported that data points were discussed such as recidivism. It was discussed that exploring a central data collection software would be beneficial as this would help collect specific data.

Brown has been helpful with questions on this process. The group will continue to monitor federal grant opportunities and update as they become available.

St. Peter stated that a change to SB123 funding language is an area to look at. As of now, only Community Corrections can utilize this funding, and this is only if they are sentenced to Community Corrections. Opening this funding source so that Court Services can utilize it is an area to look at. He stated that SB6 is another bill that can be looked at. This is because it left out the treatment component for felony DUI.
